– Revised April 14th, 2021**

Equipment & Hand Sanitization

Before Program Starts

- Ensure participants have sanitized their hands prior starting their session. Hand sanitizer provided to every team. It is the responsibility of the coach to request more hand sanitizer if needed.

After each session

- Players will sanitize their hands.
- Coaches will sanitize balls and cones with bleach spray. Bleach spray will be provided to every team. It is the responsibility of the coach to request more hand sanitizer if needed.
